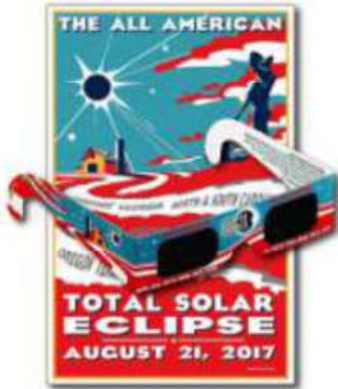

## NCCC CONVENTION INFO 2017

Registration for the 2017 convention opens January 2, 2017. The registration form will be available on the NCCC web site, however, hotel reservations will need to be made via a phone call to the hotel in Bowling Green. The information will be with the registration instructions. You will need an NCCC number for each room reserved. The hotel will also collect one room night when you register. PLEASE DO NOT try to call before that date. The hotel cannot help you until January 2<sup>nd</sup> during regular business hours [8 am – 5pm CT].

The registration instructions will also have the overflow hotels across from the host hotel. Not a busy street so easy access to all events.



The first solar eclipse to make a swath across the US in almost 100 years takes place on August 21, 2017. Bowling Green is close to the totality region. But about an hour away near Hopkinsville, KY is the greatest eclipse where totality will be just over 2 minutes long vs about a 1 minute and 24 seconds in Bowling Green. There is also a bus tour to go to Hopkinsville, KY.

We have also planned the car shows and rallye for Monday.
